Re: CBOE - Power Shutdown Saturday, September 4, 2010

On Saturday, September 4, 2010 the Facilities Department will be conducting maintenance to the electrical infrastructure network within the building. In order to complete this work, a shutdown of power is required for the entire building including the Data Centers and Trading Floor. The power-down window will be between the hours of 08:00 a.m. (0800 hrs Saturday 9/4/10) through 8:00 a.m. (0800 hrs Sunday 9/5/10). The power down will affect convenience power (plug power), lighting, computers, elevators and potable water.

As a result:

- **During the power down window, no one will be allowed access into the building.**
- **Trading Permit Holders are asked to power down their respective equipment / computer systems on Friday, September 3, 2010 before they leave for the weekend.**
- **Trading Permit Holders should arrange to come in and power up their respective systems on Monday, September 6, 2010 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. (noon). Access into the building will be permitted through the main entry (North Side). Those looking to gain entry will be required to have a building ID.**
